A501 OLD MARYLEBONE RD (MARYLEBONE ROAD TO EDGWARE RD) Upcoming day-time footway reconstruction and night-time resurfacing works

I am writing to let you know that we will be completely replacing the A501 Old Marylebone Road's southern footway between Harcourt Street and Edgware Road. We will also resurface the road between Homer Street and Edgware Road over 4 nights. Our works will take place between 30 October 2023 to 08 December 2023. The details of our works are set out below:

Both streets to be signed on Chapel Street as "resident access only". • No vehicle access to Old Marylebone Road from Marylebone Road, Homer Street and Homer Row

How our works may affect you

Pedestrian access to all properties will be maintained throughout the works, however parking will be restricted in the areas of work. We have agreed the working hours with Westminster City Council, and we will make every effort to finish the works on time and to programme, although poor weather conditions may mean we need to reschedule at short notice. All noisy works for the night-time carriageway resurfacing works will be completed by 12:00.

Walking routes, cycling and Bus journeys

Buses will not stop at Bus Stop EQ (Edgware Road) between 30 October and 2 December. The nearest stops for the 27,205, N27 and N205 are Marylebone Townhall Stop P and Sussex Gardens Stop ES. Between 8pm to 6am from 4 to 8 December, buses will be diverted to Paddington Station via A501 Marylebone Road. Customers should alight at Stop P Marylebone Town Hall for Old Marylebone Road.
